Warning:

The Lumière Lyon 2 University has 2 campuses. I.S.Rivers is taking place at the “**Berges du Rhône**” campus (in Lyon), not to be confused with the “Porte des Alpes” Campus (in Bron).



▪ By Public Transport of Lyon (TCL)

T1 Tram: leave the tram at the “Quai Claude Bernard” stop

T2 Tram: leave the tram at the “Centre Berthelot” stop

▪ By car (to the “Berthelot” parking lot)

By A7 south motorway: Follow signs for “Feyzin Lyon-Centre”, then N7 Chambéry Grenoble Lyon Rive Gauche. Cross the “Pont Gallieni” bridge. Continue on the “Avenue Berthelot” (N7). Then turn right into “Rue de Marseille”, to the parking lot.

By A7 north motorway: Take the Fourvière tunnel. Cross the bridge and turn right. Follow the “N7” direction. Cross the “Pont Gallieni” bridge. Continue on the “Avenue Berthelot” (N7). Then turn right into “Rue de Marseille”, to the parking lot.

By Geneva/Bourg en Bresse on the A42: Follow signs for Lyon centre. Take exit 6a Porte de la Doua Lyon centre. Continue on the “Laurent Bonnevey Boulevard”, then on the “Quai de Gaulle”. Continue on the left bank (fr. Rive Gauche). Turn right into the “Quai de Serbie”, up to the “Quai Claude Bernard”. Turn left into the “Avenue Berthelot” (N7) and right into “Rue de Marseille”, to the parking lot.

By Grenoble on the A43: Follow signs for Lyon centre / Mermoz. At the end of the motorway, take the “Avenue Mermoz”. Turn right into “Rue Berliet”. Continue on Rue de l'Epargne. Turn left into “Rue Garibaldi”, then right into “Rue Marc Bloch”. Continue on the “Rue de l'Université”. Turn left into “Rue de Marseille”, to the parking lot.

▪ By bicycle

The city of Lyon provides self-service bicycles called “Velo'v”. Docking stations near the university: “Universités Lyon III / Lyon II” and “St Luc / St Joseph” on the quai Claude Bernard.

Le Selcius restaurant is located in the Confluence district of Lyon.

- Access from the Lyon 2 University: Tramway T1 (towards ‘Debourg’), stop at “Hôtel de Région-Montrochet”, followed by a 10-minute walk (ie. a 20-min journey in total).

- After the evening: the last T1 Tramway departures at 00:13 from the “Hôtel de Région-Montrochet” stop. Beware, most of the Lyon metro lines close around midnight.

The 150-hectare Lyon Confluence area is situated between the Rhône and the Saône. This fast-growing district combines modernity and sustainable development. A guided walk of this new urban area will allow you to discover its issues, the Docks of Lyon, Parc of Saône, nautical base and river stop.

1 - The nuclear power plant of St Alban St Maurice

Departure by coach at 13:30, back at 18:30 at the Lumière Lyon 2 University.

>> Because of security regulations in a power plant, participants to this visit can enter the site only if they bring their valid ID card or passport (which copy has already been sent to the secretariat). Electronic equipment, pictures and cameras (of all sorts, mobile phones included) are forbidden in the power plant, they will have to be dropped off at the Public Information Centre of the plant.

The site is not accessible to wheelchair users.



2 - Discover the issues related to the Rhone River near Péage-de-Roussillon

Departure by coach at 13:30, back at 18:00 at the Lumière Lyon 2 University.

Please bring closed shoes, adapted for walking on a nature reserve path.



3 - Urban bicycle ride: the Rhône river at the service of the city

Departure by bicycle at 13:30, back at 18:00 at the Lumière Lyon 2 University.

Getting around Lyon

Public transport of Lyon

The Public transport of Lyon is called TCL (www.tcl.fr)

The city center is well served by the TCL's network with 4 subway lines, 5 tramlines and many bus lines.



Timetables

The subway and the tram run from 05:00 to midnight.

Be careful, some bus lines don't run at night!

To go to the Lumière Lyon 2 University:

T1 and T2 trams go to the Lumière Lyon 2 University.

Public transport fares

You will be able to buy tickets at the I.S.Rivers reception desk, with a choice between:

- Special ticket called "Ticket Pass Congress". This ticket is valid for one day and costs 2.50 €
- Ticket valid for 1 hour on the whole network, at 1.70 €

The Rhônexpress tram from the Lyon St Exupéry Airport

The "Rhônexpress" tram connects the Lyon Saint-Exupéry Airport to the center of Lyon (Part-Dieu station) in less than 30 minutes, from 04:25 (am) to midnight (www.rhonexpress.fr).

Departures every 15 minutes between 06:00 and 21:00.



Rates: One-way ticket = 16,10 € / Return ticket = 27,80 €

By car

The university is situated in the city centre of Lyon, it is thus difficult to park. The "Berthelot" parking lot (99 rue de Marseille) is situated near the university (please see the map on the next page).

Vélo'v: self-service bicycles

You can rent bikes through the service of "Vélo'v" (www.velov.grandlyon.com)

You will easily find "Vélo'v" docking stations in the city centre of Lyon. You can buy an access card for 1.50€ (valid 1 day) or 5€ (valid 7 days). The first half hour is free.



They are available in the city centre of Lyon, including near the Lumière Lyon 2 University.

Beware, payment is by card only.
